







DESIGN FOR A LATHE BENCH

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Russel E. Frushour, a citizen of the United States, residing at South Bend, in the county of St. Joseph, State of Indiana, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Lathe Bench, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a front perspective view of a lathe bench, showing my new design;
