

DESIGN FOR A LATHE OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Russel E. Frushour, a citizen of the United States and resident of South Bend, in the county of St. Joseph, State of Indiana, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Lathe or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

The figure is a perspective view of a lathe or

similar article showing my new design. The side of the bench which is not shown is of the same appearance as the right side which is shown.

The dominant features of my design reside in the portions shown in full lines.
